

Exhibition “What to wear” – “Päälle pantavaa” at Wahlberg Museum House main floor

This exhibition is a showcase about clothing of the people of Uusikaupunki in the 19th century.

We dress according to our own preferences or possibilities every day. At the time, people's clothing was also influenced by e.g. the division of manners that dictated the framework for dressing.


The Päälle pantavaa exhibition mainly presents the clothes of Uusikaupunki bourgeoisie from the 19th century. The exhibition consists of women's, men's, and children's clothes as well as a wide variety of accessories such as shoes, hats and umbrellas. A large part of the clothes that ended up into museum collections are more festive than every day. In addition, there are various uniforms on display, such as



soldiers' and policemen's clothes. The exhibition also has a lot of photographs of the fashion of the people of Uusikaupunki at the turn of the 19th and 20th centuries.

In connection with the exhibition, there is a play corner, especially for children, where you can arrange clothes and hats in the style of the past. In addition, there are coloring tasks suitable for the topic.


Cruises to the Isokari Lighthouse island

Cultural History Walk -brochure

The Tourist Office provides a brochure on the Cultural History Walk, which allows you to explore on your own the history and sights of the city. The cultural walk is a four-kilometer-long historic walking trail along which most of the downtown tourist attractions are located.

The brochure shows a map and a short description of 33 different sights.

UkiAR – augmented reality application

Learn about the town and its history with a virtual guide
Experience the history of Uusikaupunki in an entirely new way!

The augmented reality application UkiAR provides an interesting pastime that you can engage with whenever it suits you best – by yourself or with friends and family. The application includes 14 unique story points scattered around the Kaupunginlahti bayside and the town centre.

In the application, you are guided by a 19th century maid called Rauha who will join you at the story points marked on the map. She has somehow got stuck in time and can tell you about the history of our seafaring town from a period of about 150 years. She will also show you some old photographs from the collections of the Uusikaupunki Museum.

The content of the application has been created in cooperation with local businesses, tour guides, the Uusikaupunki Museum, and Uusikaupunki Culture and Tourism. It is part of a project managed by Ukipolis Oy and funded by Leader Ravakka and various local companies.

Go outside and explore Uusikaupunki - Find the hidden statues!

Hidden Play is a series of small bronze sculptures hidden in the terrain that can be searched for using a digital or printed map. Each route comes with a mobile game that helps you look at the environment from different angles and learn new things. The search is free of charge for the participants. Hidden Play is a combination of community art and treasure hunting games (eg geocaching). Young people have made statues at workshops, brainstormed, and planned a route.

The route is suitable for everyone: residents, school classes, seniors, work groups, travelers, etc. The route runs on both sides of the bay and is about 4-5 km long.

Myllymäki Windmill Park

Myllyrinne 3, Uusikaupunki

The hill is home to four historic windmills, many flowerbeds, steps, millstones and a children's playground. The northern side has an arboretum where different tree species are marked with signs. There is also an old water tower on the hill that functions as an observation tower, but unfortunately there is no longer a possibility to get up to the tower.

Velhovesi ring route

Cycling routes in the northern archipelago in Uusikaupunki. The main route is 50 kilometres long. Accommodation, food services, scenic resting places with stories of local history, as well as beaches and direct sale available. You can rent bikes (also e-bikes) at Tourist Information Office, Rauhankatu 10. Santtioranta Camping, address Kalalokkukuja 14, hires bikes and e-bikes, too.

Are you an outdoor person and nature lover?


Uusikaupunki offers great opportunities to enjoy nature and fresh air. We have several nature and hiking trails, some provided with lean-tos and camping fireplaces.

Skatepark/pumptrack

The pumptrack and skatepark can both be used free of charge 24 hours per day, it is located at the end of the town bay. Skatepark (300 square meters) welcomes BMX riders, skateboarders and scooter riders to practice and build confidence in their chosen sport. The park offers various types of obstacles, and is suitable for users of all ages and levels.




A pumptrack is a playground (about 1000 square meters) for bike and roller sports, from bmx to skateboarding and scooter riding. Pumptrack offers a perfect structure for practicing balance on wheels, and for learning new skills and building confidence. The pumptrack is safe and fun to ride for all ages and skill levels.

The Tourist Information Office – Welcome!



Provides advice and service on all matters related to Uusikaupunki travel: places to visit, events, brochures, maps, guide distribution, program packages for groups, bicycle rental (also e-bikes), fishing permits for Uusikaupunki town.

The office sells Uusikaupunki -themed postcards, books etc, Crusell Week products, etc. Guests have free access to internet. The Citizen´s service Passari is in the same building as the tourist office.
